### **Executive Summary**

This document provides a summary of the potential practical cases collected and categorised so far in the i2connect project. These practical cases are examples of successfully established cases which demonstrate advisor/innovation broker involvement and support for interactive innovation projects, activities within the i2connect partners, third parties and their networks.

According to the initial plan the web based catalogue of potential case studies will be implemented and used to deliver an online reference pool of potential case studies tied to the activities of T2.1 and T5.7. This will have a built-in categorisation to ensure a diverse and unbiased selection of cases. The catalogue will be open and capable of being easily populated and updated with information from the practical cases. Task leaders and project partners will help to populate it, while advisory networks (EUFRAS, IALB, SEASN) will participate by promoting the inclusion of cases from members. The online catalogue will include a strong representation of EIP-agri Operational Groups and cases from CEE countries. The target was 100 successful practical cases by M8, growing to a catalogue of up to 300 cases in the course of the project. Unfortunately first target amount is not reached at the moment and only 72 practical cases have been received by M12. These cases were selected for their potential and relevance to i2connect based on the methodology agreed in Task 2.1 (D2.1) and their potential for analysis and further study in the field review process (Task 2.4 and 2.5). An initial 70 cases have been categorised and from within this listing D2.2a, ten best practice cases have already been selected for the initial field review (T2.5). The collection process (T2.2) is ongoing and will be updated with new practical cases added to the list by month 24 (D2.2b) and month 48 (D2.2c). Further selections of practical cases for field review will be made from the updated listings. Additional sources of practical cases will be the practical case competition described in T5.7. From these practical cases the most interesting and innovative will be selected for the online catalogue. The online catalogue will be developed and published in the project's website.

# 1.0 Background and Context of practical cases of interactive innovation

#### 1.1 Context of Task 2.2

The aim of the i2connect project is to build the capacity and motivation of agricultural and forestry advisors in interactive innovation methods and improve their support roles in innovation networks. Advisors will be better enabled to



effectively support interactive innovation processes and thus contribute to faster and more successful innovations in rural areas.

WP 2 of the i2connect project aims to identify advisory best practice that helps interactive innovation projects to be successful. All partners in the i2connect project have submitted potential practical cases (T2.2). Practical cases are examples of successful multi-actor projects, activities and networks which partners feel or expect could provide opportunities to analyse and learn how they were successful and in particular the role that advisors played and continue to play in supporting these particular cases (T2.4 and T2.5).

#### 1.2 Objective of Task 2.2

The objective is to collect data relating to interactive innovation cases from within the i2connect project partner organisations (except CIRCA) as outlined in D2.1. This is to provide a listing of potential cases with explanatory and contextual details which would enable some of these cases to be reviewed as part of the field review process T2.4 and to enable some of the farmer and advisor actors in each of the selected cases participate as peers in reviewing other successful cases (T2.4 and T2.5).
