

i2connect Train the Trainers Training 2024

Objectives

- Create a common understanding of:
 - what interactive innovation is and why it is important.
 - the role of the innovation facilitator, the attitudes and competences involved.
- Create an understanding and awareness of the different levels that are important for interactive innovation:
 - Meta level: Provide tools for analysing/reflecting the interactions in the interactive innovation network and give space to try them out.
 - Participation process: Provide and try out tools to accompany interactive networks.
- Offering space to try out, practice, experiment and reflect on tools, processes etc. ...
- Collectively and individually reflect on the common learning process.

Principles

- We use concrete cases and learn from concrete examples.
- We focus on a selection of the most important methods and choose them wisely (with goals in mind) so as not to overwhelm the participants.
- To make it easier for participants to get an overview, we try to make a simple classification of the methods.
- We involve the trainers at an early stage and consider with them how they could play their part.
- We offer support and coaching if required.
- We set priorities and focus on what is most important (e.g. getting to know each other and practicing methods, time for individual and collective reflection, ...)
- We consider the individual situation and experiences of the trainees.

Pedagogical objectives

At the end of this seminar, participants will be able to:

- Plan and lead a 3-day training course on interactive innovation with a second trainer,
- Experiment tools supporting interactive innovation with groups of 10 to 12 people,
- Be familiar with the main resources/literature on interactive innovation,
- Plan a concrete training project on interactive innovation in their country,
- Receive useful feedback from their peers to strengthen their own skills as trainers,
- Actively contribute to building a team of i2connect trainers.
